Commitment to Safety and Professionalism

SPFA's multi-level certification is a rigorous and extensive program for professionals who install spray polyurethane foam (SPF) insulation and roofing. It is the only SPF industry certification program developed, designed and operated in compliance with internationally recognized ISO-17024 standards. Applicants must:

-  Complete a chemical health & safety course provided online by the Center for the Polyurethanes Industry (CPI).
-  Pass the Professional Certification Program exams related to the levels of certification being pursued, including all lower level exams for those pursuing higher level exams. Master Installers must pass a field-conducted exam.
-  Document spraying experience, and completion of CPR, first aid and OSHA safety courses (OSHA 10- or 30-Hour card) for higher levels of certification by SPFA.
-  Maintain certified status annually and recertify every five years with SPFA.



SPFA issues ID cards to individuals who earn certification.
